About Our School

We pride ourselves on being a warm, caring school with a strong Church of England ethos. We have approximately 200 pupils on roll, split into 7 classes from FS (Reception) to Year 6.

What is EYFS?

The Early Years Foundation stage (EYFS) sets standards for the learning, development and care of children from birth to 5 years old. All schools and Ofsted registered early years providers must follow the EYFS, including preschools, nurseries and school reception classes.

At Brompton-on-Swale CofE Primary School, EYFS consists of:

Busy Bees Pre-School for children aged 2-4 years old and FS Class for Reception aged children between 4-5 years old.

What makes EYFS at Brompton-on-Swale unique?

In FS at Brompton, we live our **HEARTS** vision by supporting our children to be: **H**appy, **E**ducated, **A**rticulate, **R**espectful, **T**eam-players and **S**afe.

We also have our own curriculum which determines what our children learn: *All About Me > Our School > Our Community > Our World > Our Planet*

This ensures we give our children experiences beyond the EYFS Framework, whether it be a visit from Richmond Fire Service (*Our Community*), to celebrating the Hindu festival of Diwali (*Our World*) to planting spring bulbs in the village (*Our Planet*).
